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Tumoral Calcinosis an uncommon condition

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Abstract

Background: Tumoral calcinosis is an uncommon condition. Tumoral calcinosis can be classified into 3 types: primary normophosphatemic tumoral calcinosis (the most common), primary hyperphosphatemic tumoral calcinosis, and secondary tumoral calcinosis **Case discription:** A 14 year old tribal presented with progressive swelling over right elbow. Radiographs revealed a multilobulated, calcified, progressive mass measuring 11x4x9 cm. Excision was performed, and Histological findings confirmed the diagnosis of tumoral calcinosis **Conclusion:** Tumoralcalcinosis is a rare entity. Hence, the surgeon must be aware of this possibility.
